

*Water sod immediately after installation

* Water for 2-3 hours

**If multiple stations water each station for 2-3 hours

*Turn off the sprinkler and lift a block of grass up. You will want to make sure the ground is completely saturated underneath the entire area of the block and not just around the outside seams. You should have moisture an inch deep into the ground. If the center area of the ground is still a little dry water for another hour and check again.

*After the first watering, start watering St. Augustine grasses (Raleigh, Palmetto and Floratam) in the morning hours. Watering St. Augustine grasses late in the evenings can create a fungus and brown patch.

*During the Spring when temperatures are in the 70's and low 80's water the sod every 2-3 days for 2-3 hours for the first two weeks after installation. After the first two weeks water the sod just once a week or as needed.

*During the Summer months when temperatures are in the upper 80's and above water the sod every other day for 2-3 hours for the first two weeks after installation. After the first two weeks water the sod just once a week or as needed.

*During the Winter when temperatures are below 50 degrees water the sod every 4-5 days for 2-3 hours for the first three weeks after installation. After the first three weeks water the sod just once a week or as needed.
